


Sunday 17 October 2021 @ PPT Bovey Tracey & St Mary's Hennock 20th Sunday after Trinity



The Vicar writes

This Sunday at PPT we begin a short sermon series on Paul's Letter to Thessalonica. Paul probably wrote it while he was in Corinth in 50AD, which makes it the earliest Christian document we have, written before the gospels themselves. Paul was only able to spend a few weeks in Thessalonica before he was driven out by persecution, so he is anxious to encourage these young Christians to stand firm in the essentials of faith that he had taught them.



We have the luxury and privilege of time to learn and understand - may we learn to be faithful and fruitful, and confident of the faith we have been given.

The Sunday morning services are 9.30am Sunday Praise, with the Lord's Supper, and 11am Morning Worship. After the 5pm Prayer & Praise we are planning to take the marquee down- all helpers would be welcome!

If you have not yet responded to our **Autumn Appeal**, please do so as soon as possible. We have raised £3350 towards to the target of £5000 for the office pod, but we also need people to volunteer for many different roles if we are to sustain our life as a church fellowship.

Discussion Questions:

Icebreaker: How and where did you learn the basics of Christian faith?

Read Acts 17.1-14. How long did Paul stay in Thessalonica? Why didn't he stay longer?

read 1 Thess 2.17-3.6. Paul sent Timothy back to Thessalonica to find out how they were doing, and Timothy reported back to Paul when he was in Corinth (Acts 18.5)

Read 1 Thessalonians 1.

What signs does Paul see that the faith of Thessalonians is genuine? (vv 3-6)?

How does Paul describe the change that the gospel made in their lives? (vv 9-10)

How does Paul describe the Christian hope? v.10

Application: How would we respond if all our ministers (clergy, readers etc) were driven out of town? Do we understand enough to stand firm on our own?
