Read Luke 11.37-54: Jesus has just publicly criticised those who demand a sign as 'a wicked generation'. On what grounds does Jesus now criticise the Pharisees and Lawyers? What authority does he claim? (v49)

Their focus was on achieving ritual purity through detailed observance of rules. What does Jesus say they have neglected? (v.42, 52)

How should we aim to please God? (1 Jn 3.17) Can we set aside the moral teaching of the bible? (Luke 11.42)
