Collect for the Queen's Accession

Almighty God, the fountain of all goodness, bless our Sovereign Lady, Queen Elizabeth, and all who are in authority under her; that they may order all things

in wisdom and equity, righteousness and peace, to the honour and glory of your name and the good of your Church and people; through Jesus Christ your Son our Lord, who is alive and reigns with you, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, now and for ever. Amen.

Mon 7 Feb: Ps 30, Leviticus 19.1-end

Pray for the arts and media to inspire our imaginations for the furtherance of the gospel and the extension of the kingdom.

Tue 8 Feb: 36, Leviticus 23.1-22

Pray for Graham attending the meeting of General Synod in London until Thursday, and for good relationships of understanding to be established between new Synod members.

Wed 9 Feb: ps 34, Leviticus 23.23-end

Pray for the Peninsular Gospel Partnership day at St Leonard's Exeter, focussing on the place of music in worship, and for Andy Fenton leading the session.

Thu 10 Feb: Ps 37, Leviticus 24.1-9

Discussion Questions:

Icebreaker: Have you ever had to keep watch all night? How can you stay awake and alert?

Read Luke 12.32-48. Jesus is continuing to teach his disciples how to seek the Kingdom. What does it mean to seek God's kingdom? (v.31)

Jesus tells two stories based on the reality of the classical household. What was life like as a slave in the ancient world? Is Jesus commending slavery?

Jesus tells us that 'the Son of Man is coming at an unexpected hour' (v.40) What were the disciples expecting? (Acts 1.6) What should we expect?

Why does Peter ask his question v.41, and how does Jesus answer it?

What responsibilities does the household manager have? (v.42)

Why might a manager start to abuse his position? (v.45) How did the Jewish leaders abuse their authority? (Lk 11.39f, 20.47) How have Christian leaders abused their authority?

What does this passage teach us about the mission of the local church?

Pray for all Christian leaders to discharge their responsibilities with wisdom.
