Discussion Questions:

Icebreaker: how do you cope with life's trials and temptations? Who do you blame or hold responsible?

Introducing James: who is he? Whose brother is he? vv.2, 16 See also John 7.5, 1 Cor 15.7, Acts 15.13

To whom is he writing? What is the Dispersion (ESV)?

It is well worth reading the whole letter through and highlighting repeating words, phrases and ideas. What do you think the big theme is in the letter?

James urges us to see things differently: why should we rejoice in trials? (see also Romans 5.1-5)

What do- or-should- we most desire? v.4, 12. Should Christians hope for a reward? (see also Mt 5.12)

Why can the lowly brother boast/take pride in a high position, and the rich in a lowly position? See also Isaiah 40.6-8

What is the difference between trials (vv 2, 12 and temptations (vv 13-14)? What are the different ways of dealing with them?

What does the bible mean by wisdom? How do we acquire it? What stops the man in vv6-7 from gaining it?

How does God help us in times of trial and temptation?

James is writing not just to individuals but to a church community: how we can help one another in our trials and temptations? See also 5.19-20

Pray that we may be a church community that cares for the wanderer, and perseveres in faith.
