Discussion Questions:

Icebreaker: If there is no resurrection or afterlife, as many today sadly believe, what is the best way to use the days of our life? (cf 1 Cor 15.32)

Luke is careful to establish, but not embellish the evidence for the resurrection:

Did the women go to the wrong tomb?

Did the women see Jesus raised from the dead? (cf John 20.15-18)

Did the apostles believe the women's report of the angels' words?

Look at Acts 10.42-43. What does the resurrection of Jesus mean for us? If Jesus is raised, how should we live?
