Discussion Questions:

Icebreaker: have you ever been jealous of someone or coveted something?
Is Jealousy always sinful? Of what is God jealous? (v.5 : compare Ex 20.5 and 20.17)

Read James 4.1-5 and vv 11-12. What is the state of community life in the churches to which James is writing? What causes fights and quarrels in home and church life today?

What spiritual forces are at work? (look at vv 1, 4, 7, compare with 1.14, 3.6, 3.15)

What do you think James means by 'friendship with the world'? Why is this 'adultery'?

read James 4.6-10: Can we be confident of reconciliation with God if we have made him jealous with our adultery? (v6, 10)? What precious promises does this passage give us?

What does it mean in practice to 'submit to God'? (v.8). Should Christians be miserable? (v.9- compare Philipians 4.4-7, Matthew 5.3-4)

What does it mean to slander (NIV) 'speak evil against' (ESV) one another (vv 11-12)?
How is this speaking against the law? (see also 2.12). Who alone can pass judgment?
