Discussion Questions:

Icebreaker: Do you watch 'talent shows' like "Britain's Got Talent"? What talent or gift would you bring?

Read Romans 12.1-13 How does Paul want us to worship God - what kind of sacrifice? (vv.1-2)

How is the church fellowship like a human body? (v5)? What happens to a body that does not have use of its limbs or members?

Paul gives several different lists of spiritual gifts (*charismata*) in different letters- see also 1 Corinthians 12.4-11, Ephesians 4.7-13. You may want to compare these lists. How do the gifts in Romans 12 help up to build up the body?

How should we discern our own gifts? (Rom 12.3) What if others don't seem to recognise our gifts (1 Cor 12.15-17) How should we encourage the gifts of others?

What matters more than gifts? (vv 9-13)

Where is our church fellowship struggling? What gifts are needed?

What gifts do we have to offer the local church and community? How could your talent be recognised and nurtured?
