Tearfund- Mission Focus for September

Tearfund has been working alongside local churches in some of the world's poorest places for more than 50 years. There are currently offering aid in Pakistan after the recent devastating floods. Tearfund sent an email this week requesting prayer and support:

"Some of the heaviest rains that have ever been seen in the region have left a third of the country under water. More than a thousand people have been killed; and around a million homes damaged or destroyed. People have seen their whole way of life washed away. There is a desperate need for food, safe drinking water and shelter. Our local partners – including the church in Pakistan – are responding right now."

Icebreaker: How many charitable appeals do you get. -from the church, in the post etc? Must we respond to all of them?

Discussion. Luke 16.19-31

Jesus continues his warning on the spiritual danger of wealth, with a story drawing on common Jewish and Greek perceptions of God's coming judgment. We do not need to believe that actual conversations between Abraham and 'hell' (Greek Hades) take place, but Jesus uses, and does not correct the general picture.

What evil does the rich man do in his lifetime? (Compare 1 Tim 6.3-19, James 5.1-6)
Does the rich man know about Lazarus? (V27) or care for him?

What warning of the danger of judgment has God provided for us? (Vv27-30)

Given Jesus' own resurrection, why does he say in this parable that a resurrection appearance (by Lazarus?) will not convince the rich man's brothers?

Application: We may not like talking about money and lifestyle, but worrying in silence is not healthy. What standard of living should we aim for, particularly when people around us are facing severe pressure in the economic crisis?
