Study Questions:

Icebreaker: How do you think about what the future holds? Christians have a glorious hope, but can obsess about detailed prophecy, or try to ignore it.

Read Luke 21.5-28. Where is history leading? vv 9, 28 Is God still in control?

Jesus warns of many troubles (vv 11, 25)
What effect will these have on the world? v26
How should Christians respond? v. 9, 28
What particular dangers face followers of Jesus? v.8, 12, 16-17
Why is Jerusalem so important to the disciples? v.5
Should they try to defend it?vv 20-21

What is important enough to us to risk our lives in defending it? vv 12, 17 read about persecuted Christians, and pray for them regularly.
