Icebreaker: how important to you is the teaching of the bible? How much/often do you read it?

Read Acts 20.17-end. This is Paul's farewell address to the church leaders of Ephesus, where he had ministered for 3 years.

How does Paul's manner of life authenticate his message?(vv.19-20, 33)

What does Paul mean by saying "I am innocent of the blood of all" (v.26) - see also Ezek 3.16

What was Paul's message? (v.21, 24, 27)

What dangers does Paul warn against? (v29-30) - see also Matthew 7.15

What will be able to protect them from danger? vv28, 32

Why do we need to know the whole counsel of God?

What practical means and habits will enable the word of grace to build us up?
