## Study Questions:

Icebreaker: what sign helps you look forward to the end of winter and coming of summer (snowdrops, daffodils, cuckoo etc)

Read Luke 21.25-38 What does Jesus mean by 'seeing the Son of Man coming in a cloud.." (V.27)

What did Jesus expect to happen in the lifetime of "this generation"? (v.32)

What signs give you hope that Jesus's kingdom is coming, and peace and justice will be established, despite all the bad news in the world?

What happens to our lifestyle if we forget that Jesus will return? (vv34-38)?

How can we help each other to sustain our faith and hope?

Live as though Jesus may return today. Work as though he won't return for 30 years

#### Mon 5 Dec: Ps 44, Isa 45.14-end

Pray for the life of our high streets, that small shops and businesses may survive against online competition and through the economic recession.

#### Tue 6 Dec: Ps 56, Isa 46 (St Nicholas)

Pray for generosity to those in need not to be eclipsed by the season. For the Food Hub based at the Methodist Church
