Study Questions:

Icebreaker: Which is the most urgent of the many problems in the world? Who might be able to solve them?

Read Jn 1.29-51. We meet some of the future disciples of Jesus. How are they connected, and who introduces them to Jesus? (vv. 35, 41, 45)

What parts of Jesus' story, familiar from gospels like Mark, Matthew and Luke, does John not tell us? Does he expect us to know the story from the other gospels?

How do they describe Jesus to one another? (vv 36, 41, 45, 49).

How does Philip cope with a difficult question he can't answer? v.46

These verses are packed with a depth of Old Testament expectation. John provides a translation of many Jewish terms ('rabbi', 'Messiah', amen') - why?

How does Jesus describe himself? v.51

The gospel of John has already raised the theme of people's reluctance to believe in Jesus (1.4, 10-11). Why do these disciples come to faith so easily and quickly?

Mon 9 Jan Ps 89 10-29, Exodus 14.15-22

Give thanks for the work of the Christian Institute, and pray that Euthanasia and assisted suicide may not be introduced into the UK through the state of Jersey.

Sat 14 Jan Ps 33, Amos 5.18-end

Give thanks for the faith and service of Anne Brown, and pray for her family and friends at the Thanksgiving service today.

Sun 15 January Ps Ps 145,1-12, Jeremiah 1.4-10
