Read Exodus 3.13-22. Why is the 'name' of God so important an issue?

What does God mean by saying "I am who I am" (I have been/I will be). cf Jn 8.55-57

Why does God's plan involve rejection by Pharoah? v.19

Do people today really *know* the name of God? How will they learn?
