Icebreaker: What subjects or lessons did you find difficult to learn? Did you want to learn them?

Read Exodus 8.20-10-29:

Do you see any recurring patterns in the plagues?

Over which elements of creation does God exercise authority? (8.21, 9.3, 9.9, 9.18, 10.13, 10.22

How does he choose to limit his power? (8.22, 9.3, 9.26, 10.19)

Should we see the hand of God in natural disasters today? (cf Luke 13.1-5)?

How many times does Pharoah repent and ask for prayer? (8.28, 9.27, 10.16)

How does the Lord show mercy and restraint? (8.30-32, 9.15, 9.33, 10.18

How does Pharoah respond to the Lord's mercy? (8.32, 9.34, 10.20)

Who learns from the plagues to fear the word of the Lord? (9.20, 10.7)

Mon 27 March Ps.73, Jeremiah 21.1-10.

Pray for the emergency services to bring swift help to those in trouble - for the ambulance service, our retained firefighters, and the Police and Coastguard.

Tue 28 March Ps. 35 Jeremiah 22.1-5,13-19.

Wed 29 March: Ps.55 Jeremiah 22.20-23.8

Are you grateful that God has had mercy on you - or do you think you deserve it?

How should we live differently in the knowledge of God's power to judge, and his gracious restraint in doing so?
