Study Questions: 1 Corinthians 2.6-16

#### Ice-breakers:

What does Wisdom mean to you? Does it mean the same today as it did to Ancient Greeks or to Jews? (see Proverbs 1-2) or Is Christianity anti-intellectual?

Read 1 Corinthians 1.18-2.5 again. Why does God want to 'destroy the wisdom of the wise' (v.19). How does God destroy this wisdom? (v.27-30)

Read 1 Corinthians 2.6-10.

Who are the rulers of this age (v.6)? Why did they crucify Jesus (v8)?

What is God in his wisdom planning 'for our glory' (v7) and 'preparing for those who love him' (v9)? What decisive event has opened the way for this plan to succeed?

Read 1 Corinthians 2.10-16

Paul's use of the word 'spirit' can seem confusing: he may be deliberately using the vocabulary of the Corinthians but giving it new meaning.

What does it mean today to say that someone is 'Spiritual'?

How is a man's spirit like God's spirit? v.11

What does this passage teach us about the Spirit of God? (vv 10-13, v16 cf Isa 40.13))

Who can receive the Spirit of God? (vv 6, 9) (cf Acts 2.38, Acts 10.37-45)

In v.14-15 Paul compares the man without the spirit (NIV) / the natural man (ESV) (psychikoi) with the spiritual (*pneumatikoi*).

If the natural man cannot make sense of spiritual things, what is the point of preaching the gospel to them? (2 Cor 4.1-6)

Paul is preparing the ground to tackle the disunity (chapter 3) and spiritual arrogance (chapter 4) among the Corinthians.

What are the temptations or dangers of thinking that we are spiritual? (1 Cor 4.7)

What does it mean to have the mind of Christ? (v.16) (cf Philippians 2.1-8)

Application: pray that we may always remember that the Spirit is God's gift to those who repent, believe and love the Lord, and grow in the true wisdom of humble obedience to the Lord.

#### Mon 3 July Ps.92, 2 Sam.15.17-21

Pray for the family of Joan Codner, whose funeral is held at PPT this afternoon.

## Tue 4 July Ps.89.1-18, Nehemiah 5.

Pray for all those who are homeless; those who are refugees; those who are fleeing their homes because of violence, persecution, loss of food and water supplies and those who live on our city streets. Give thanks to all the voluntary organisations trying to help them.

# Wed 5 July Ps.119.105-128, Nehemiah 6.1-7.4

Pray that the Monthly Prayer meeting would be better supported, and that we would unite in fervent prayer for the unity of the church and fruitfulness in mission.

#### Thu 6 July Ps.92, Nehemiah 7.73-end of 8

Give thanks to Dawn for setting up the weekly sewing and craft group; for providing a space where we can relax, drink tea, eat cake and enjoy the company and conversation of others.

#### Fri 7 July Ps.88, Nehemiah 9.1-23

Pray for Graham and all the members of General Synod meeting in York from today until Tuesday 11 July- for honest and realistic debates to address the dangers of decline and disunity in the church.

#### Sat 8 July: Ps.97, Nehemiah 9.24-end.

We pray for the fair resolution of the Junior Doctors' strike, that emergency treatment will still be given and that the safety of patients will not compromised whilst the Doctors are absent.

## Sun 9 July: Ps.55, 1-15,18-22. Deut.24.10-end.

Pray that the teaching and pastoral ministry at PPT would be faithful and fruitful, building us up as God's Temple to live for God's glory.
